Alhamdulillah, SAHUC has and will continue to publicise its Audited Financial Statements on its website for public information.

SAHUC is tax compliant and registered as a PBO (Public Benefit Organisation) as is required by the Income Tax Act.

The Board considers all expenditures and disbursements with due care and in compliance with our mandate.

SAHUC signs the Protocols with the relevant authorities in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia upon receipt of an invitation directly from the Ministry of Hajj and Umrah. Such signing is concluded in the presence of the South African Consul General's office. SAHUC is confident that neither SAHUC nor the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia or the Republic of South Africa and their respective institutes are in violation of any international law with regards to the Protocol. SAHUC enjoys a productive and constructive relationship with all the aforementioned parties and express its confidence in the continuation of all the processes.

SAHUC will endeavour to continue to serve the South African pilgrim in a professional, efficient and transparent manner.
